Achievement #5

Explore our nature center and see wildlife up close. Discuss extinction, endangered species, and the duties of conservation officers. Includes a live animal demonstration.

AMERICAN INDIAN LIFE

(Elective 24 - a, b)

Find out who was living in the area before the Europeans. Learn about their home, how it was made, and the materials used to make it. See a model of what their home would have looked like. Make and play Native American games.

NATURE CRAFTS

Elective 12

Learn about nature as you make solar prints, collect and press leaves, collect seeds, and build and use a bird caller.

WEBELOS CUB SCOUTS

Naturalist Badge

Explore our nature center and see wildlife up close. Learn about bird flyways, poisonous plants, and venomous snakes as you complete this badge.

Forester Badge

Hike Hidden Valley's trail with a naturalist to look at native plants and trees. Study different types of forests in the U.S., examine growth rings on a tree stump, and discuss the benefits and risks of both wildfires and wildfire prevention.

Geologist Badge

What is a fossil? How are they dated? How are mountains formed? Discover the difference between a rock, mineral, and an element, and whether a rock is sedimentary, igneous, or metamorphic. Learn how to make a mineral hardness scale to identify different rocks and which rocks and minerals you use in everyday life.
